



# **Getting Into God's Playbook**

**John 12:26** "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will answer."

In the game of football, players who are often written into their coach's playbook, to make the big plays, are those who know how to play their position well. They are where they're supposed to be when the ball is given to them. They must not only know their position well but know how to position themselves to make the great plays. When a coach recognizes their ability to consistently make the plays, they become an integral part of His playbook.


God's Playbook continued from page 1
