In this message we see how the birth of this child was the realized hope for Mary, the mother of Jesus. It gave her the faith that was needed as she raised this child for God.

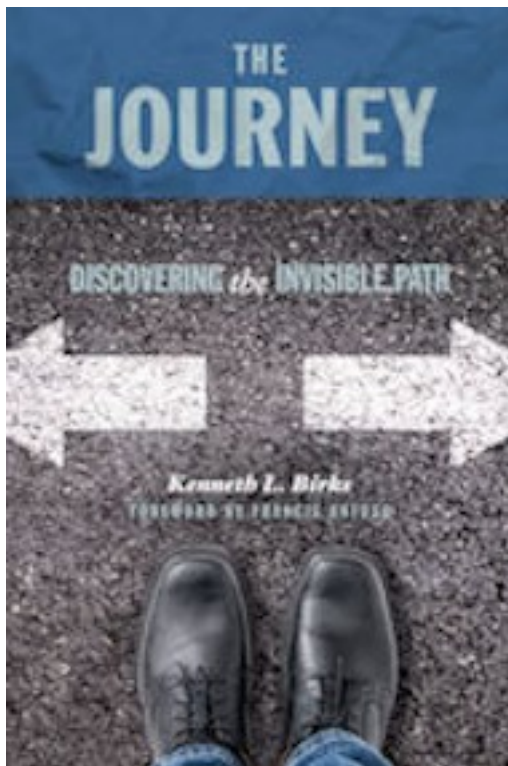
The Birth of Christ.
