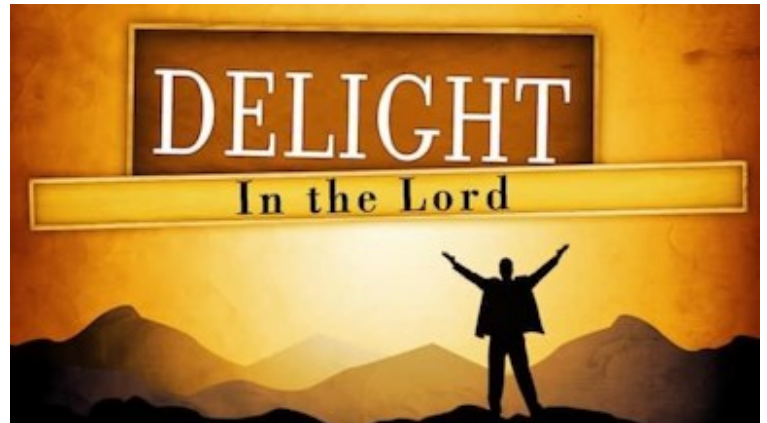

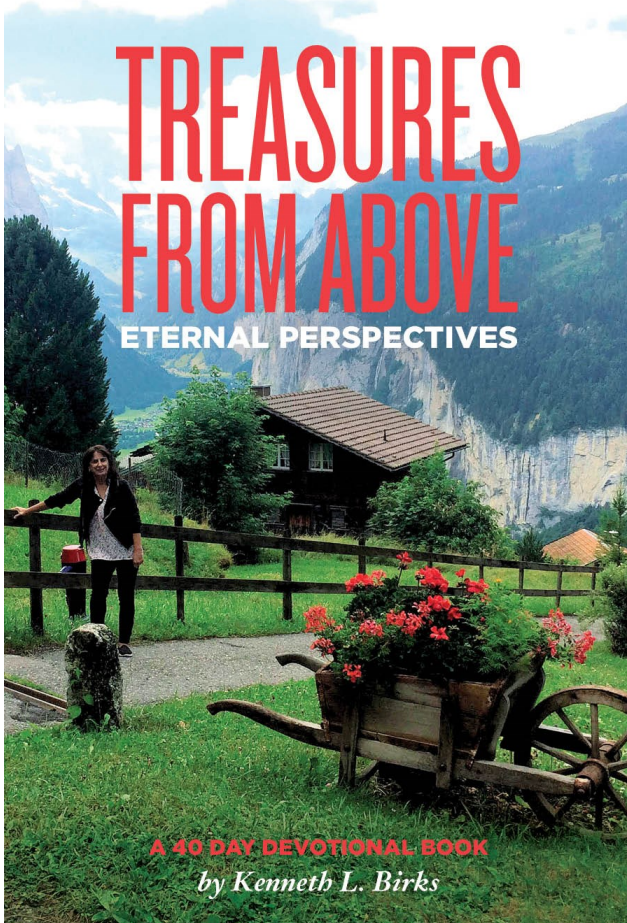

Delighting in God's Love

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him might be saved.

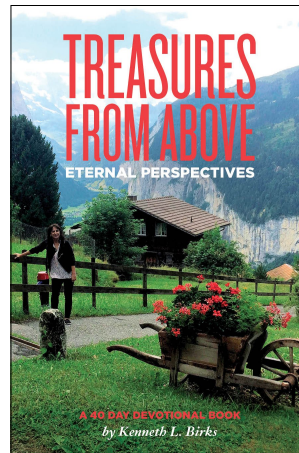

Dealing with Strongholds
