

Is God about to do something extraordinary? This is a question to ponder if we want to be a part of the prophetic fulfillment of the times before the Second Coming of Christ—The Day of the Lord. As the prophet Joel declares, we are to sound the alarm and warn all that the Day of the Lord is at hand. Now is the time to make ourselves ready as His instruments of righteousness.

Joel 2:1-2 Blow the trumpet in Zion and sound the alarm in My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble; for the day of the Lord is coming, for it is at hand.

In Peter's sermon following the healing of the lame man at Solomon's Porch in the book of Acts, he makes the point that Jesus will not return until the restoration of all things has occurred and everything spoken by the prophets is fulfilled. The above passage is a prophetic statement concerning the times we are entering. We are at a point in time when our worldly climate demands that we prepare ourselves. Revelation 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and her wife has made herself ready.



1 Corinthians 12:4-7 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. ⁶ and there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. ⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all.

The term "works" means active operation, productive, powerful, dynamic, efficient, fervent, and mighty in showing forth. The word "manifestation" means to make visible, clear, and known. With these two definitions in mind, we can see that it is the Father's desire for us to be vigorous and mighty in showing forth and making His power visible through the gifts of the Spirit.

An end-time anointing is coming before the return of Jesus Christ that will be far greater than anything that has occurred throughout the earth's history. God is now commissioning us to fulfill the words of Jesus when He said, "You will do greater works than I." This anointing will come suddenly like a mighty rushing wind, as it did with the early disciples in the Book of Acts. So now is the time, as Christ's bride, to make ourselves ready. 



Bible Study — How to Enter Into the Sanctification Process with the Lord



When we accept Christ as our Lord and Savior, we step into His righteousness, which covers all of our sin and shame. The Father only sees us through the righteousness of Jesus. He sees us as being perfected forever, as the writer of the book of Hebrews expresses so adequately. However, the sanctification process is an ongoing experience as we work out our salvation in fear of God.

Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.

When we are saved, the work of Christ is finished in our lives, but the work of the Holy Spirit is just beginning. He has much work to do as He leads us inexorably towards total conformity to the image of Christ.

One of the essential keys to our growth and maturity in the Lord is to understand the sanctifying process. It is through the sanctifying operation of the Lord that our ears are trained to discern the voice of the Lord as He guides and directs our lives to be all that we can be in Christ. As we yield to the Holy Spirit in this process, He conforms us to the image of Christ because this is the direction of the predestinated purposes of God.

2 Corinthians 3:17-18 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

The key to staying in this process is to keep our eyes rested on the Lord. As we behold His image in our thoughts, we are gradually changed into His image from glory to glory. By meditating on all of His wonderful attributes, the mind of Christ begins to take shape in us as old ways of thinking dissipate. As we give ourselves to the study of His Word, His ways and thoughts are embedded in our hearts and spirits, transforming and renewing our minds with a new perspective on life. All things become new as the old gives way to the newness that is now changing us.

When we are baptized in the Holy Spirit, the fire of God comes to refine us, burning the sinful chaff in our lives as we are changed from glory to glory. This is what helps us to be free from the fire of judgment. The prophet Isaiah also mentions this in a portion of Scripture, when he speaks of the spirit of burning that causes the Branch of the Lord to be beautiful and glorious -- *Matthew 3:11 & Isaiah 4:3-4*.

One of the most significant areas of uncleanness that we must deal with is the lusts of the flesh. These are areas that continually war against who we are in Christ. It is as we purpose to walk in the Spirit that we won't succumb to them while the fire of God continually burns the chaff of ungodly desires from us.

Galatians 5:16-18 I say Then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another so that you do not do the things you wish. ¹⁸ But If you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

Our part in the sanctification process is to yield to the Holy Spirit, who is the One who convicts us of sin. As we respond to His gentle promptings in these areas, He gives us the victory we need, which causes us to triumph over the lusts that war against the soul. As we put on the characteristics of the new man, the Holy Spirit is leading us into; the old nature begins to disappear. We find that our desires are now toward all that God is doing in us rather than being dictated by the lusts of the flesh and the cultures of the world.

Conversion and sanctification are designed to necessitate a definite break with the corruption caused by sin. When we come to know God through Christ, we not only escape the corruption of sin but also are renewed and restored to the divine image. The provision of the divine nature through repentance from sin and faith in Jesus Christ, along with the power of the Holy Spirit, belongs to the divine sovereignty of the Lord. However, the application and fulfillment of these are the human responsibility of every believer. The Bible says, "We are to put on the new man."
